### Notes from the President

It has been months since my last posting. I hope that everyone is doing well and is healthy.

We have received calls about members not being able to get the gate open to enter the grounds. The key to opening the gate is to flip up the cover, enter the correct code (changes every year at the end of January to the new code for the current year — unless notified of a special circumstance) and turn the knob. Keep in mind that one way locks it and the other opens it. If you turned it the wrong way, it will not open which will cause you to have to start the procedure over and turn the knob the other way.

I would prefer to be positive and encouraging when posting but unfortunately there are individuals that either refuse to follow rules or cannot read the posted ones. The following need addressed:

- Someone has driven down over the hillside to the lower pistol range and tore
  up the grounds. There is to be NO vehicles driven over that hill except the
  tractors to cut the grass (unless during a special work party requiring extensive repairs).
- Members have continued shooting 223 on the silhouette and pistol ranges.
   This is a neck-down cartridge that should only be shot at the rifle range. We have these rules in place for the safety of not only our members but our neighbors. This information is also posted at each range, the clubhouse and in the information packets.
- There is to be no shooting past the firing lines at any of the ranges. This is for everyone's safety and clearly posted. The excuses that one does not know or they think the rules have changed do not apply.

Please follow the rules that you have agreed to when you signed your application for membership to be able to experience the shooting sports in a safe environment.

### Changes to Antlerless Deer License

In November 2022, Senate Bill 431 was signed into law. This law allows hunters to buy antlerless licenses through the HuntFishPA automated licensing service. It goes into effect for the 2023/2024 license year. Licenses will be available to purchase online or in person at any license issuing agent.
