Bowhunting in Pennsylvania

A new study by the Archery Trade Association announced that the estimated total number of bowhunters across the US in 2021-2022 was 3.7 million. Pennsylvania was ranked as 9% of those figures. They stated 331,000 archery licensees were sold; however, the Game Commission shows 360,984 sold which includes juniors and seniors bowhunting with privileges within combination licenses. No other state came close to the Pennsylvania numbers.

If you've ever wondered why bowhunting is so popular, here are a few reasons:

- There are more days available within the archery seasons. For 2023/2024, hunters will have 61 days statewide.
- There is the added benefit of two extra hours of shooting during archery season. This allows more working people time to hit the woods later.
- More opportunities for big game. Last year, 737 bears were taken during archery. Pennsylvania also has an archery-only elk season.
- Archery seasons are usually during warmer temperatures.
- Archers are able to hunt during the whitetail rut periods.
- Archers have more opportunity for spots hunting. They need to only worry about 50-yard safety zones vs. firearm hunters observing 150-yard safety zones.
- Archery equipment is compatible with all sizes and capabilities of hunters.

Hopefully these tips, courtesy of the Pennsylvania Game News, help sway your interest with bowhunting this season.

PA State Park Spotlight

<u> Presque Isle State Park</u>

Presque Isle State Park is a 3,200-acre sandy peninsula that sits along Lake Erie. As Pennsylvania's only "seashore," Presque Isle offers many recreational activities, including swimming, boating, fishing, hiking, bicycling, and in-line skating.

Things to do while visiting this park:

- *Beaches:* There are 13 beaches to pick from when visiting the park. Swimming is only permitted when the lifeguards are on duty. Concession stands, restrooms and picnic tables can be found throughout the park.
- *Biking:* With the flat terrain, you won't want to miss out on the 13.5 miles of bicycle trails throughout the park. Don't have a bike? Don't worry, you can rent them within the park for a small fee.
- *Bird Watching:* There are over 300 different avian species that call Presque Isle their home.
- *Boat Tours:* Lady Kate is a touring boat that docks near Commodore Perry Monument. Tours last approximately 90 minutes and are narrated. You can also take a free pontoon boat tour which leave from the dock adjacent to Misery Bay near the kayak rentals. These tours are 50 minutes and fill up quickly.
- *Fishing:* Even though a special stamp is required to fish on Lake Erie, it is something that everyone should try at least once. Anglers have caught bass, walleye, perch and steelhead.
- *Hiking:* There are over 11 miles of hiking trails. This is great for those that don't want a difficult hike as the park is relatively flat. Be sure to check which trails are open before heading out. Trails can be marshy or underwater when the lake is high.
- *Kayaking:* Feel free to bring your own kayak or rent one near Graveyard Pond. You will be able to see areas that are unreachable by land.

Pennsylvania Game Commission Jr. Game Warden Camp



On Wednesday, July 19, the PA Game Commission Southwest Region Office will host their 2023 Jr. Game Warden Camp. The camp is open to youth ages 12 to 15.

Campers will spend the day with game wardens, gaining insight into the job and the Game Commission's mission of managing and protecting the state's wildlife and habitats while promoting hunting and trapping. Campers will join wardens in light physical fitness, activities, confidencebuilding exercises and at hands-on learning stations. Campers will learn about wildlife forensics and methods used by wardens to catch poachers and solve wildlife-related crimes. Other activities will involve wildlife-capture techniques, woodland tracking and outdoor survival.

The camps begin at 8 a.m. and end at 3 p.m. Registration can be completed online via the link at the bottom. Registration is limited to those who have not attended a camp held previously and is limited to 40 participants.
