Youth Wildlife Art Contest

The George Montgomery/NRA Youth Wildlife Art Contest is open to students grades 1 through 12 (including home-schooled children).

Entries are sorted into one of four categories, based on school grade:

- Category I: Grades 1-3
- Category II: Grades 4-6
- Category III: Grades 7-9
- Category IV: Grades 10-12

Entries must be signed by the artist and portray any North American game bird or animal that may be legally hunted or trapped. Endangered species and non-game animals, such as eagles and snakes, are not eligible subjects. To confirm whether a certain animal or bird is eligible, please visit the contest animal website <u>North American Game Birds & Game Animals (nra.org)</u>

Contest starts September 1 and entries must be received by October 31, 2023 to be eligible.
