### Winter Indoor .22 Pistol Bowling Pin Shoots

This year's launch of the indoor .22 pistol bowling pin shoots will be led by Paul Angelicchio and Dan Nave. The shoots will be held on the first and third Fridays each month (December – May), with days off around New Years and Easter. The goals for this year are to be safe and have fun. The cost per week is \$5.00

#### The rules:

Safety: CMP Pistol Safety rules.
Scoring: CMP Pistol scoring (overlay or plug)
Pistol: Any .22 pistol (Iron or Optical Sights)
Position: One hand or two handed. No artificial support.
Course of Fire: 5 relays with 5 shots per shooter (25 shots total per week) 2 or three shooters per relay
Target: Bowling pin printed on an 11x17 target

### Scoring:

Body of the Pin	1 Point	
Head of the Pin	2 Points	
Red Stripe	3 Points	
Miss	0 Points	
75 points max per target per week.		

The event starts at 7:00 PM on the dates below:

Dec 6th and 20 <sup>th</sup>	Jan 17 <sup>th</sup>	Feb $7^{th}$ and $21^{st}$
Mar 7 <sup>th</sup> and 21 <sup>st</sup>	Apr 4 <sup>th</sup>	May 2 <sup>nd</sup>

We are looking to make the shoots a little more interesting this year. Of the 9 matches this year, your top 5 scores of weeks 1 through 8 will be used to set your position going into the final week (May 2<sup>nd</sup>) for the overall championship (You can miss a couple weeks and still be in competition). To be eligible for the championship you must shoot the May 2<sup>nd</sup> match, which will be the 6<sup>th</sup> match counting for the championship. We're looking at awards such as Top shooter, Top female shooter and biggest waste of ammunition. Come out and have fun!
