#### <u>Grants</u>

The NRA Foundation grant was received. The week of June 17<sup>th,</sup> the club took delivery of the match 1761 Anschutz (\$2412) with 7020 Anschutz sights (\$665), which was in addition to the Walther air rifle received earlier this year. Almost \$4100.00 this year from the NRA.

Midway USA Foundation approved the range improvement grant for ISA to benefit the junior club. This includes the roof and chimney replacement on the clubhouse, a small addition for the junior club and a new exhaust fan for the impact area of the indoor range. The foundation deposited \$12,629 to the team account. The chimney has already been replaced. The roof is scheduled for replacement in July.

The junior team also requested a cash grant from the Team Endowment of about \$1100.00

#### <u>2023/2024 Season</u>

The team completed the 2023-2024 season with awards being presented at the May ISA meeting. The ISA Post 228 and Norwin HS teams will start the 2024-2025 season in September.

## Game Commission Needs Volunteers

The PA Game Commission, along with the Hawk Mountain Sanctuary has started the third Pennsylvania Bird Atlas. From now until February 2029, this study will document the birds that are living in Pennsylvania.

In order to accomplish this large task, they are looking for volunteers to look for birds, document any they see and report the details to eBird (<u>Pennsylvania Bird Atlas - Discover a new world of birding... (ebird.org</u>)

Those who are interested should visit the website and create an account to access all the information and tools needed. You will find a volunteer handbook with printouts and be able to track what others are seeing in real time. There is no level of expertise needed to volunteer. ## **Anterless Deer License**

- Licenses went on sale to PA residents in WMUs 1B, 2G and 3A on June 24.
- Licenses for all remaining WMU's for PA residents will be on sale June 27-July 27.
- Licenses for non-residents will be available on July 8.
- July 22 will start the second round of license sales for resident & non-residents.
- August 12 will start the third round of license sales for resident & non-residents. The sale of Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) permits will also be sold at this time.
- August 24 a hunter can additional licenses until reaching their personal limit of 6.

#### The 2024/2025 Deer Season starts September 24, 2024 and runs till January 25, 2025.
