ISA is excited to announce the upcoming session of the Daisy BB & Air Rifle Instructional Course on Sunday, October 6 at 2:00 PM. This course will help youth prepare for shooting competitively with our Jr. Rifle Team or local 4-H clubs. The course will be run by Dan Nave.

This is a 6 week instructional course for youth ages 7 to 12 who are interested in shooting competitively. The students will meet at the ISA Clubhouse on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month from 2:00 PM—3:30 PM The students will learn firearms safety, proper handling of a firearm, cleaning the firearm and the 4 positions of competitive shooting. At the conclusion of the course, each student will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

The cost of the course is \$10.00 per student. This covers the cost of the ammunition used in the class. Each student will be required to have safety glasses at each class. Hearing protection is optional.

State Game Land Tours

The Pennsylvania Game Commission will once again offer driving tours through state game lands. Ten tours are scheduled for 2024, The tours allow the public to see opportunities on game lands and how habitats for wildlife are being protected.

All tours are free, held rain or shine and are open only to vehicles licensed for travel on public roads.

Sunday, October 13

State Game Lands 26, Bedford County, 12:00 PM—3:00 PM. The public is invited to tour State Game Lands 26, a 12,000-acre tract situated in Blue Knob. The tour begins off Route 869 near the Bedford/Cambria county line and covers approximately 7 miles. Participants will find ample opportunity to enjoy the historical aspects of the game lands and the quality habitat improvements conducted by Pennsylvania Game Commission habitat crews in partnership with cooperating organizations such as the National Wild Turkey Federation. Work by the Game Commission forestry staff also will be showcased through with the viewing of vast timber production brought forth through timber sales and timber stand improvements.

Sunday, October 20

State Game Lands 51, Fayette County, 11:00 AM—4:00 PM. This tour will be a 5-mile, self-guided, one way driving tour and will highlight mountainous terrain and early fall foliage on the Chestnut Ridge and this 16,945-acre game lands. The tour will begin on the game lands road across from the Game Commission Crew Headquarters at 268 Dunbar Ohiopyle Road, Dunbar, PA 15431. The tour will conclude where the game lands road meets Green Brier Road in Wharton Township. Items of interest along the tour route includes several forestry projects to improve habitat for wildlife, herbaceous openings that have been planted to provide food for wildlife, native pollinator fields and areas where the Game Commission releases pheasants. Habitat crews, biologists, foresters and game wardens will be on hand to answer any questions. Visitors will be able to see the equipment the Game Commission uses to manage the game lands for wildlife.
